The award was presented by the Boston Global Forum (BGF) and the AI World Society (AIWS) at Harvard University, USA. It recognizes his significant contributions to global peace-building, reconciliation, and humanitarian service. The 2025 award marks the 10th anniversary of the award (2015–2025), honoring leaders with moral courage, visionary leadership, and compassion. The focus of the 2025 award is on advancing 21st-century peace through inner harmony, interfaith dialogue, and ethical governance.*

***Explanation:** India has been named Country of the Year at BIOFACH 2026, the world's largest trade fair for organic products, held from 10–13 February 2026 in Nuremberg, Germany. Agricultural and Processed Food Products Export Development Authority (APEDA) under the Ministry of Commerce and Industry is organising India's participation. India Pavilion will cover 1,074 square metres with 67 co-exhibitors including exporters, Farmer Producer Organisations (FPOs), cooperatives, labs, and state bodies. Organic products like rice, spices, pulses, oils, fruits, and essential oils will be showcased from over 20 States and Union Territories.*

It offers integrated cybersecurity, unified multi-cloud management, and Artificial Intelligence (AI)-based analytics. It allows real-time processing, automation, and predictive risk analysis for licensed financial institutions. It reduces dependence on foreign cloud providers and strengthens regulatory control.

Q4. Which country won the FIH Men's Junior Hockey World Cup 2025?

Explanation: Germany won the International Hockey Federation (FIH) Men's Junior Hockey World Cup 2025, defeating Spain 3-2 in a shoot-out after a 1-1 draw in regulation time. The final was held at Mayor Radhakrishnan Stadium in Chennai, concluding the 13-day tournament that began on November 28 and was held across Chennai and Madurai. Justus Warweg scored for Germany in the 26th minute, while Nicolas Mustaros equalised for Spain in the 33rd minute. India won the bronze medal, defeating Argentina 4-2, marking their first bronze and adding to their previous tally of two golds and one silver in the tournament.

It has no state-wise fund allocation and includes schemes like Guru-Shishya Parampara Repertory Grant, Cultural Function and Production Grant (CFPG), Tagore Cultural Complexes (TCC), Scholarships and Fellowships, and Financial Assistance for Veteran Artists. It supports infrastructure, research, festivals, Himalayan and Buddhist heritage, and reimburses Central Goods and Services Tax (CGST) under Seva Bhoj Yojana. The scheme promotes cultural preservation, training, infrastructure creation, and supports artists financially.
