It is an international community-based programme developed by the Intergovernmental Oceanographic Commission (IOC) of the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO). The programme aims to build resilient coastal communities through tsunami awareness and preparedness. Its main objective is to reduce loss of life, livelihoods, and property during tsunamis. Communities must meet 12 indicators covering risk assessment, preparedness, and response. Tsunami-ready villages show hazard mapping, evacuation plans, public display boards, 24-hour warning systems, and regular mock drills.*

The mobile unit is a computer lab with internet, audio-visual tools and training modules. It will visit schools, colleges and Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs).*

*Explanation: Kala Sanskriti Vikas Yojana (KSVY) is a Central Sector Scheme of Ministry of Culture that provides financial assistance to cultural organizations and artists, including Scheduled Castes, for promotion of art and performing arts across India. It has no state-wise fund allocation and includes schemes like Guru-Shishya Parampara Repertory Grant, Cultural Function and Production Grant (CFPG), Tagore Cultural Complexes (TCC), Scholarships and Fellowships, and Financial Assistance for Veteran Artists. It supports infrastructure, research, festivals, Himalayan and Buddhist heritage, and reimburses Central Goods and Services Tax (CGST) under Seva Bhoj Yojana. The scheme promotes cultural preservation, training, infrastructure creation, and supports artists financially.*

**Q7. The Kopra Medium Irrigation Project, recently in news, is proposed in the core area of which tiger reserve?**

The diversion lies in the core area of Veerangana Durgavati Tiger Reserve in Madhya Pradesh. Veerangana Durgavati Tiger Reserve is located in Madhya Pradesh. It includes areas of Nauradehi Wildlife Sanctuary and Durgavati Wildlife Sanctuary. The reserve lies across the Narmada and Yamuna river basins.*

**Q8. The Bihar government recently approved the installation of the first Grain ATM machines in which city as a pilot project?**

*Explanation: Bihar approved the first three grain ATM machines in Patna as a pilot project. Grain ATM, also called Annapurti, is an automated machine dispensing wheat or rice. The technology was developed by the World Food Programme in collaboration with the Food Corporation of India and state governments. Machines operate 24x7 and can be solar-powered. They use internet connectivity to access the Public Distribution System database and the profile of Below Poverty Line cardholders.*

**Q9. Male Mahadeshwara Wildlife Sanctuary is located in which state?**

*Explanation: Recently, a 12-year-old male tiger was brutally hunted, dismembered, and buried in Male Mahadeshwara Wildlife Sanctuary, four months after a previous poisoning incident. The sanctuary is located at the intersection of the Western and Eastern Ghats in Chamarajanagara District, Karnataka. It was declared a wildlife sanctuary in 2013. It is contiguous with Biligiri Rangaswamy Temple (BRT) Tiger Reserve, Sathyamangalam Tiger Reserve, and Cauvery Wildlife Sanctuary. It is home to the famous Male Mahadeshwara Temple, dedicated to Lord Shiva (Mahadeshwara). The sanctuary is bounded by the Kaveri River to the northeast and Palar River to the south.*

The portal serves as an integrated, user-friendly platform where people can register grievances related to any government department without technical difficulties. Complaints, jurisdictions, and departmental officers have been pre-mapped in the system to ensure clarity and faster resolution. Citizens can file complaints through four modes: the portal, mobile app, call centre (1902), and offline submission at the Chief Minister's Office. A three-tier grievance redressal system has been introduced, comprising a Grievance Redressal Officer, an Appellate Authority, and a Final Appellate Authority.*



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
