Q1. Sujeet Kalkal won which medal at the Under-23 World Wrestling Championships 2025?

Explanation: India's Sujeet Kalkal won gold at the Under-23 World Wrestling Championships 2025. He competed in the men's freestyle 65 kg category and defeated Umidjon Jalolov of Uzbekistan. Kalkal secured a 10-0 victory in just 4 minutes and 54 seconds, winning by technical superiority. This marks his first-ever world title, showcasing his dominance on the mat. He earlier won two U-23 Asian titles and one U-20 Asian Championship gold, making him one of India's rising wrestling stars.

Explanation: Sweden has become the world's first cashless country, replacing physical money with digital payments through phones and cards. Travellers can easily pay anywhere – from shops to northern lights tours – using digital transactions. The transformation began with the launch of Swish, a mobile payment app introduced in 2012. Swish enables real-time money transfers between individuals, businesses, and organizations using just a phone number. Its fast adoption made digital payments common across shops, cafés, museums, and even churches. This shift marks a major milestone in Sweden's journey toward a fully digital and cash-free economy.

Q3. Who has become the first Indian to win a medal at the Judo Junior World Championships 2025?

Explanation: Judo player Linthoi Chanambam made history by winning India's first-ever medal at the Judo Junior World Championships in Lima, Peru in 2025. She is 19 years old and competed in the women's 63 kilogram category. Chanambam won the bronze medal by defeating Joni Geilen from the Netherlands. Earlier, she lost her final Group D match to So Morichika of Japan. This achievement marks a historic moment for Indian Judo on the world stage.

Q4. The AIM-120 Advanced Medium-Range Air-to-Air Missiles (AMRAAM) is developed by which country?

Explanation: A week after Pakistan Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif's Washington visit, the United States (US) confirmed supplying advanced air-to-air missiles to Pakistan. Pakistan will receive AIM-120 Advanced Medium-Range Air-to-Air Missiles (AMRAAM) under a modified arms contract with Raytheon, US defence company, valued at over \$2.51 billion. The AMRAAM is a beyond-visual-range (BVR) missile with 'fire-and-forget' capability, speed up to Mach 4, and all-weather operation. AMRAAM is developed by the United States, compatible with F-16 jets, and also used on F-15, F-22, F-35, and other fighter aircraft worldwide.

Explanation: The government has launched a nationwide campaign 'Your Money, Your Right' to help citizens reclaim unclaimed financial assets such as bank deposits, insurance proceeds, dividends, shares, mutual funds and pensions. The campaign began on October 4, 2025, and aims to return dormant financial assets to their legitimate owners through simplified, district-level support mechanisms. Between October and November 2025, citizens successfully reclaimed around ₹2,000 crore of unclaimed funds. From October to December 5, 2025, dedicated camps were organised in 477 districts, involving public representatives, district administrations and financial institution officials.

Scheme covers 2,110 medicines and 315 surgicals, medical consumables, and devices, including cardiovascular, anti-cancer, anti-diabetic, anti-infective, anti-allergic, gastro-intestinal medicines, and nutraceuticals. Target is to open 20,000 Jan Aushadhi Kendras (JAKs) across India, including Dadra and Nagar Haveli, by 31 March 2026.

It is one of the world’s largest aircraft engine MROs and the first global engine OEM (Original Equipment Manufacturer) MRO set up in India.

Explanation: In Jaipur, nearly 250 families continue to preserve Kathputli, one of Rajasthan’s oldest folk art traditions. Kathputli is a traditional string puppet theatre form that originated in Rajasthan. Historically, travelling performers used Kathputli shows to narrate stories of Rajput kings, brave warriors, folk heroes, and moral tales to village audiences. The word Kathputli comes from kath meaning wood and putli meaning doll, highlighting its simple wooden structure. A Kathputli puppet is made using wood, cloth, thread, and metal wire, with a wooden upper body and cotton and fabric below.
