1. It is proposed to conduct a Selection for promotion to the post of Chief Commercial Cum Ticket Supervisor (CCCTS) in Level-06 against 75% Promotion Quota in Commercial Department of LMG Division through CBT/TBT as per instruction of Railway Board communicated vide RBE No.47/2025.

2. Eligibility and Service Conditions:-

2.1. Employees working in the grade of Sr. Commercial Cum Ticket Clerk (Sr. CCTC) in Level-5 are eligible for promotion to the post of Chief Commercial Cum Ticket Supervisor (CCCTS).

2.2. Employees who have completed 02 (Two) years of regular service in Level-5 as Sr. Commercial cum Ticket Clerk (Sr. CCTC) as on the date of issue of this notification shall be eligible to appear in the written test (CBT/TBT).

2.3. The prescribed Medical Classification for the post is B/2 (Bee Two).

2.4. The cut-off date for determining the eligibility of the employee will be date of issue of the notification.

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3. **Syllabus:-**

The syllabus for selection to the post of Chief Commercial cum Ticket Supervisor (CCCTS) against 75% DPQ is enclosed as **Annexure A** for wide publication amongst the eligible staff concerned.

4. **Procedure of Selection :-**

4.1. The exam will be held on the basis of Computer Based Test (CBT)/ Tablet Based test (TBT) as per **RBE No. 47/2025**.

4.2. The question paper will be in **English** and **Hindi languages** only. In terms of Railway Board's Letter No. E(NG)1/2018/PM1/4 dated 14.12.20218, (**RBE No.196/2018**) the question paper will be **100% objective type**.

4.3. 10% of the questions will be on **Rajbasha** (Optional). If any candidate answers more than 100, the first 100 attempted questions will be evaluated.

4.4. Since the selection is against Departmental Promotional Quota and panel will be arranged in the **order of seniority**, there will be **no negative marking** (as per **RBE 194/2019**).

4.5. The Professional ability of the employees in the field will be adjudged through written test on CBT/TBT mode. The employees must secure minimum 60% marks in aggregate i.e. in both CBT/TBT, record of service and last 03 years APAR for final selection and the **Panel will be drawn strictly as per seniority**.

4.6. Since the post is declared as Non-Safety, there will be **no pre-selection coaching/training for SC/ST** employees and the relaxation in the qualifying marks for candidates belong to SC/ST community is applicable.

4.7. Employees who have completed 02 (Two) years of regular service in Level-5 as Sr. Commercial cum Ticket Clerk (Sr. CCTC) as on the date of issue of this notification are come under the zone of consideration to appear in the CBT/TBT examination for promotion to the post of Chief Commercial Cum Ticket Supervisor (CCCTS) in Pay Matrix Level-6 of Commercial Department. Since this being a promotional quota, the employees should be called on **1:3 ratio** and the **list of eligible employees** to appear in the CBT/TBT examination is enclosed as **Annexure-B**.

4.8. Normal selection with seniority marks and 60% pass marks in the aggregate including marks of written examination, record of service and seniority. Panel being made as per seniority with 80% and above classified as outstanding in order of their seniority allowing them to supersede not more than 50% of total field of eligibility. (as per **RBE No. 17/2014**)

4.9. The date, venue and time of Computer Based Test (CBT)/Tablet Based Test (TBT) **will be intimated in due course of time**.

5. **Unwillingness & Representations/Objections against provisional eligibility list:**

Representations/Objections against provisional eligibility list may be submitted to this office within 07 days from the date of issue of this notification, failing which, it shall be presumed that there is no representation against the eligibility list.

#**Last date for submission of unwillingness:** 20/08/2026

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5.1. If any employee in Annexure "B" is unwilling for the said selection, they are required to submit/forward their unwillingness on or before 20.08.2026 in the enclosed proforma (**Annexure "C"**) to ET Cadre/DRM(P)/LMG.

5.2. If no unwillingness is received in this office on or before 20.08.2026, it will be assumed that the employees are willing for the selection.

6. Notifying to the Staff:

Wide publicity of this notification should be given amongst the all eligible staff of Commercial Department whose lien is maintained in Commercial Department of Lumding Division. Staff those who is/are on deputation/leave/sick should also be notified to enable them to submit their unwillingness in time. It shall be the responsibility of senior Subordinate/Supervisor to complete the formality in this respect. It is further advised that any other communication received in respect of the selection from time to time should invariably be intimated to all the eligible employees.

8.1. If any of the above instructions are modified or altered at a later date by the Railway Board or Headquarters, the administration reserves the right to amend these instructions accordingly to give effect to such modification.

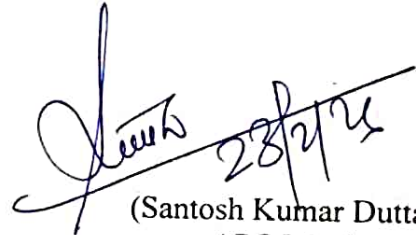

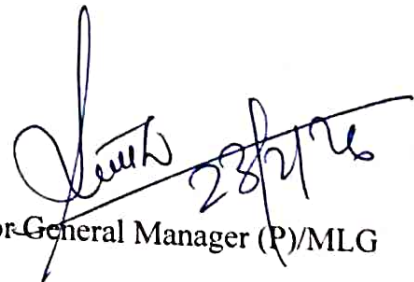
